

## **Prohibited Content Policy Ver 2.3 2010**

### **Introduction**

This policy specifically covers "ALL" work that Sumphero undertakes directly or is involved with as a 3<sup>rd</sup> party. The policy includes, all ICT network administration and Desktop support roles undertaken together with any on-line work completed to 3<sup>rd</sup> party or remote locations regardless of the origination country.

- Sumphero will not knowingly allow the display of any material that exploits children, or otherwise exploits children under 18 years of age.
- Sumphero will not knowingly post or discloses any personally identifying information or private information about children without their consent (or their parents consent in case of a minor).
- Sumphero will not knowingly provide material that is grossly offensive, including blatant expressions of bigotry, prejudice, racism, hatred or excessive profanity or post any obscene, lewd, lascivious, filthy, excessively violent, harassing or otherwise objectionable content.
- Sumphero will not knowingly sell or promotes any products or services that are unlawful in the location at which the content is posted or received.
- Sumphero will not knowingly introduces viruses, worms, harmful code and/or Trojan horses on the Internet.
- Sumphero will not knowingly promote, solicits or participates in pyramid schemes.
- Engages in any libellous, defamatory, scandalous, threatening, harassing activity.
- Posts any content that advocates, promotes or otherwise encourages violence against any governments, organizations, groups or individuals or which provides instruction, information or assistance in causing or carrying out such violence.
- In addition, Sumphero reserves the right to prohibit the use of Constant Contact by any company or site in its sole discretion.
- Sumphero reserves the right to report "ANY" illegal activity which contravenes the laws of Australia to the authorities without prejudice or prior notification to the client.
